

# Tiger Class Home Learning – Blue Group

## Mathematics

- 5 mins counting practice – counting in 2s, 5s, 10s or 3s
- 10 mins number bonds to 100 practice – start with multiples of 10 (40 and 60) and then try any number (43 and 57). Write your bonds down in your books.
- 5-10 mins 'number of the day' – see attached template, but this can be recorded in a book. Choose a different 2-digit number each day.
- 30mins calculation practice – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. See examples of questions attached and then create some of your own. Use concrete resources to help you and then record pictorially before writing your abstract answer down.  
**Remember...** multiplication is making 'groups of' and division is 'sharing' or 'grouping'.
- 10mins – create some 'real life' problems to match your number sentences e.g.  $4 + 3 = 7$ , I had 4 apples and my friend gave me 3 more. How many did I have altogether?
- Use of TT Rockstars and/or My Maths

## Phonics and Spelling

- Read and write the words from the common exception words list. Are there any common spelling patterns you could learn e.g. **should would could**? Can you recall or make up a mnemonic eg **Oh you lucky duck**?
- Practise up to 5 words using 'look, cover, say, write, check'.
- Use these words in a sentence. Check you have spelt them correctly.

## Reading

- 15 mins - Read out loud to an adult. Once fluent in reading, try adding expression then talk about what happened in the book and why.
- 25mins – Share a story with a grown up. Complete one of the reading activities after sharing and talking about the story.

## English

- Handwriting practice – choose a letter family to practise writing (see attached sheet)
- Use the daily picture prompts on <http://www.pobble365.com/> to create a piece of writing. There are some ideas below the writing to help get you started, or you can choose your own direction.
- Read your work out loud and edit – check it makes sense, improve it with more interesting vocabulary. Can you use any conjunctions e.g. and, but, because, so, if?
- Check your spellings, grammar and punctuation.
- Publish your work, thinking carefully about handwriting and presentation.
- Maybe keep a diary – write down your thoughts each day.

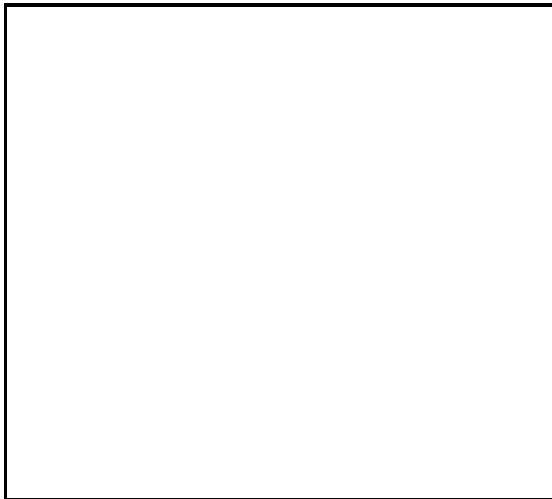

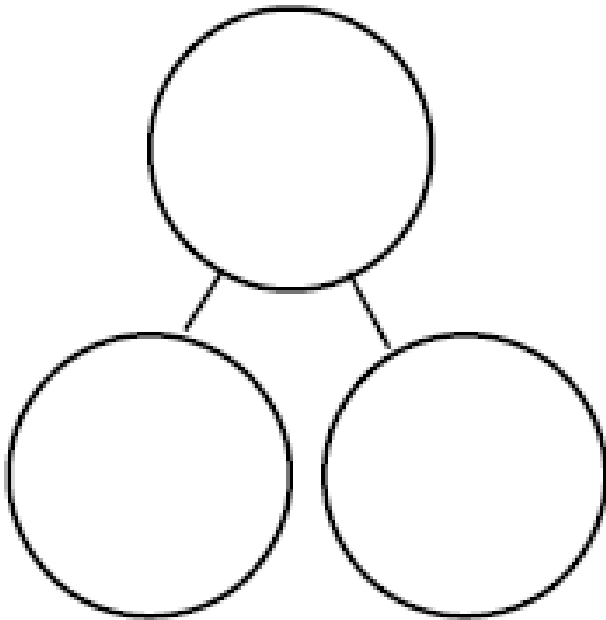

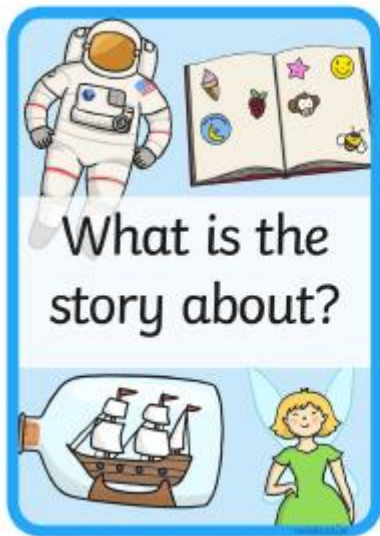
