Homework Expectation

All children have a **'reading for practice'** book. They are also encouraged to take a book or magazine from our class library for **'reading for pleasure'**, which is entirely their own choice and can be changed as often as they like. In Comet Class, children take turns to review and share a favourite book with their classmates. You will be notified when it is your child's turn to prepare a presentation. All children are expected to complete the right-hand side of their reading diary at home **on a weekly basis** please. This is shared in class each Monday when children get another brief opportunity to recommend a favourite book from their previous week's reading.

The spelling list for Y2 Common Exception Words can be found <u>here</u>. You will find the login for <u>LetterJoin</u> on the inside front cover of your child's reading diary. This is best used on a tablet or phone.

Children have access to <u>Numbots</u> for regular practice of number facts at home. Login details can be found on the inside back cover of your child's reading diary. You may also like to take a look at the <u>White Rose 1 Minute Maths</u> app which is free to download.
