Timetable

Homework Expectation

All children have a 'reading for practice' book. They are also encouraged to take a book from our class library for 'reading for pleasure', which they can change it as often as they like. In Comet Class, children take turns to recommend a favourite book to their classmates. You will be notified when it is your child's turn to prepare a presentation. Children are expected to complete the right-hand side of their reading diary at home on a weekly basis please. This is checked each Monday when the children get an opportunity to share their work with their peers.

The spelling list for Common Exception Words can be found here and a weekly etymology word task is posted on the school website. If you would like to reinforce the spelling work covered in class at home, please let Miss Mandelson know.

You will find the login for <u>LetterJoin</u> on the inside front cover of your child's reading diary. This is best used on a tablet or phone.

Children have access to <u>Numbots</u> and <u>TTRockstars</u> for regular practice of number facts at home. Many thanks for all your support with homework – it makes a huge difference.
