Dear Parents and Carers,

As we near the end of the academic year, our thoughts in school have started to turn to the end of year arrangements and the arrangements for the academic year ahead. Please find information regarding this below.

Appointment

The governors and senior leadership team are delighted to announce that we have appointed Mrs Julia Sharpley as the new Panther class teacher.
