We are supporting Comic Relief with a nonuniform day today - as ever our children are very positive in their support for others.



On Monday our ambassadors, Ellie, Amy and Oliver accompanied Mrs Peacock on a visit to Allerton Waste Recovery Park. They report: Our first impression was "Wow! - it is massive". When we went inside, we watched a video and then we did a sorting activity where we had to decide which category the rubbish belonged to, such as 'household', 'recycled', 'organic' or 'other'. As soon as we got out of the door, we could smell the most unpleasant smell which can only be described as something like rotten cheese mixed with mouldy fish! We saw how the rubbish was sorted on conveyor belts and heard how it is used to provide energy for over 40,000 homes. For example, when micro-organisms from the organic waste burp, the gas is burnt and converted into electricity! It was an amazing experience which was really interesting. We are now planning how we can help to reduce, reuse and recycle, both at home and at school.
